

What to Bring...

For your convenience, we have compiled a list of items that you will need for your new suite. This list is by no means comprehensive; rather, it is a starting point. You will be able to access your Resident Portal to get your roommate's contact information in early August. Please contact them before purchasing items for shared spaces, like the kitchen, living room, or bathroom, so that you can avoid having duplicate items. We also advise you to keep your receipts handy in case items need to be returned or exchanged.

For the Bathroom

Cup, Soap Dish and Toothbrush Holder
Rug/Bath Mat
Towels/Washcloths
Garbage Can
Toilet Paper
Toilet Brush
Plunger
(Note that a shower liner/curtain will be provided)

For the Kitchen

Pots and Pans
Cooking Utensils
Dishes, Glasses and Silverware
Dish Towels
Paper Towels and Holder
Garbage Can
Small Kitchen Appliances (toaster, blender, George Foreman grills, etc.)

For the Living Room (in 3-BR and 4-BR suites)

Lamps (No Overhead Lighting Provided)
Television
Stereo Equipment (Subwoofer speakers are not advised)
Plants & Other Decorative Items

Cleaning Supplies

Vacuum Cleaner and Bags
Mop, Broom and Dustpan
Bucket, Sponges, Rags and a Duster
Cleaners: All-Purpose, Tub and Tile, Floor,
Glass, Toilet, Bleach, etc.
Laundry Supplies (basket, detergent, fabric softener, ironing board, iron, drying rack)

Miscellaneous

Coaxial cable for TV
Ethernet cable for computer
"Extra Long Twin" Bed Linens
Bedroom Lamps
"3M" Command Adhesives / Painter's tape for posters
Alarm Clock
Surge Protectors (UL Listed only)

What to Leave at Home...

The items that are listed below are already provided at The Towers or are prohibited items, per CUNY/CCNY and The Towers' Policies and Procedures.

Items Already Provided

Microwave
Refrigerator
Window blinds

Damaging Items

Contact Paper
Wallpaper
Wall Paint
Large nails and screws
Double sided tape
Water-Containing Furniture
Animals (other than toothless fish in a 10-gallon tank)
Any hardware (i.e., bolts, nails, screws, etc.) or decoration (i.e., wall chalk, washable markers, duct tape, etc.) that will cause or leave behind damage

Prohibited Items

Candles or Incense (Cannot be used as decorations)
Hookahs or any sort of smoking device
Weapons
Illegal Drugs or Drug-Related Paraphernalia
Alcohol and Alcohol Paraphernalia
Alcohol Bottles (empty) as decorations
Fireworks or Incendiary Devices
Outdoor Grills (Charcoal, Electric or Gas)
Highly Flammable or Combustible Items
Lamps with Halogen Bulbs
Open-Flame Cooking Devices
Extension cords (except 3 wire type with surge protection)
