GENDER NEUTRAL HOUSING AGREEMENT

In keeping with the mission of The City College of New York to promote and support diversity, the Office of Housing and Residence Life at The Towers offers Gender Neutral Housing. This process seeks to provide a living environment welcoming to all gender identities; one not limited by the traditional gender binary. Gender Neutral Housing allows for same-gender, opposite-gender, non-gender or other-gender identities to live together regardless of biological sex in an environment in which they feel safe and supported.

Gender Neutral Housing participants must commit to maintaining an inclusive and welcoming living environment free of discrimination based on gender identity and sexual orientation. We hope that students who are in the process of discovering their gender identity, who do not wish to identify themselves by gender, as gay, bisexual, or transgendered students, and students who feel more comfortable with a roommate of a different gender will be able to find a more compatible roommate and living situation within The Towers. Each resident accepted to live in Gender Neutral Housing must agree to the Gender Neutral Housing Agreement.

By signing this form, I acknowledge that I am selecting to live in a suite that will be designated as Gender Neutral, which means that other residents of a differing gender or gender identity may select this space and reside with me. I also agree to commit to maintaining an inclusive and welcoming living environment free of discrimination based on gender, gender identity and/or sexual orientation.
